Working group 1: Planning Instruments

Objectives

The aim of the working group 1 is to analyse the existing implementation options, the legal framework as well as recent developments in the public building law, regarding the consideration of green infrastructure measures in development and/or redevelopment projects.

Initially, the objectives of the entire city regarding climate adaptation in internal development are considered and the instruments and options available for action for planning are evaluated. Regarding the previously defined "living labs", the application of the commonly used and available instruments will be investigated and possible actions to establish green infrastructure would be implemented in the ongoing planning process. The various stages of planning in the living labs are particularly suitable for examining key success factors as well as obstacles in the implementation of green infrastructure measures. Working group 1 addresses the

following key questions: What options and instruments are there regarding climate adaptation in internal development? Which of these have proven valuable and what are the impediments?

Methods

In terms of methodology, work package 1 evaluates dedicated literature, analyses legal texts, research projects, municipal publications, and compares best practices on the basis of literature and online research. The empirical survey will involve expert interviews with representatives of the city administration, i.e. with individuals from relevant city departments responsible for the corresponding living labs. The working group focuses on the possible courses of action.
